She lived and worked in Barcelona, Firenze, Rome, London, Berlin, Reykjavík/Iceland, back in Rio de Janeiro, she seeks new professional experiences that constantly challenge her creativity.

**2025 – Turing – Computer Software Company** – I work at Turing on projects focused on the development and improvement of written content used in artificial intelligence interfaces (including systems linked to NVIDIA). In the role of AI Teacher, I contributed to improving the quality of textual content generated by assistants and language models, making the writing more fluent, natural, and closer to human communication.
