Neighborhood Sun is a non-profit, B corporation implementing the state-sponsored Community Solar program in Maryland. As customers of BGE in zip code 20759, the BWC Mission Center and the Bishop's Residence are eligible to select Neighborhood Sun as their electrical energy supplier. By doing so, each would receive its power from a new solar farm in Jessup at a savings of 7-10% compared to BGE supplier price per kwh. The website states: "Jessup Community Solar Farm is currently under construction. It's expected to be connected to the grid and generating credits for subscribers this summer!"
