

Semester Exam Exemption Policy

Seniors are exempt from **ALL** second-semester final exams when they meet the following criteria:

- Have earned an **80%** or better each quarter
- Have no unexcused absences.
- Have not received a major referral.

Freshman through First Semester Seniors may earn **one** exam waiver of their choice per semester when they meet the following criteria:

- Students who earn **80%** or better in a class each quarter
 - No unexcused absences.
 - No major referrals.
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- Students may not use the exemption in the same class in both semesters.
 - Students may choose to take semester exams for no harm.
 - Teachers are welcome to do a lab/project as their final exam.

FIRST SEMESTER EXAM WAIVERS FOR SAT AND PSAT

Seniors who score **1000-1199** on the **SAT** exam will be allowed an additional semester exam waiver. Those students who score **1200** or better will be allowed two exam waivers. Waivers can be used in any subject area; however, students must have an 80% or better average each quarter in the subject they plan to exempt.

Sophomores who score **900** or better on the **PSAT 9** exam will be allowed an additional semester exam waiver. Juniors who score **950** or better on the **PSAT 10** exam will be allowed an additional semester exam waiver. Waivers can be used in any subject area; however, students must have an 80% or better average each quarter in the subject they plan to exempt.
