#### Reading, Storytown, Spelling and Vocabulary Assignments -

These are all due by Friday. Storytown, Spelling and Vocab tests will be available in Google Classroom on Friday and must be taken on Friday unless you request other arrangements.

- Storytown Read: The Cricket in Times Square- Complete the story comprehension questions in the provided Google Doc in your Google Classroom by Thursday, April
  2
- Spelling words are: decorative, abbreviation, admiration, association, aviation, civilization, declaration, addition, composition, preposition, abdominal, proposal, rendition, disposal, emotional, environmental, denial, facial, judicial, testimonial
  - Type each spelling word in 3 different colors in the Google Doc in your Google Classroom (find it in the Spelling section)
  - Type your spelling words in backward alphabetical order in the same Google Doc that you used for the above assignment with 3 colors
  - On Friday, take the spelling test that will be found in the spelling section of your Google Classroom. You will listen to an audio of the spelling words given orally. Please do not have any books open or notes nearby. I am trusting that you will be honest when taking tests online.
- Vocabulary words with definitions are in your work packet that was picked up at school on Monday. The words are: forlornly, fidget, pathetic, resolved, scrounging, noble, stingy, suspicion, unsavory, gilded
  - Each word should be written in a good, 5th grade sentence. Be sure to use correct capitalization and punctuation. Use the Google Doc provided in your Google Classroom under the Vocabulary section.
- Reading: Sometime before Friday, please log into AR and take a STAR Reading Test. Be sure not to take a break in the middle of the test and read every answer before making your answer choice. 4th Quarter AR goals are in and you may begin taking AR tests for the 4th Quarter at any time.
- Complete the Suffixes: Adding -est, Adding -ing, Adding -er, Adding -ed. They will be found in the packet that you picked up from school on Monday.
