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**Question 1 (Life in the House & Neighbourhood):** You are moving to a new neighbourhood. Write a letter to your cousin describing your new house. Mention the rooms, the furniture you are currently moving into the house, and describe your new neighbours or the facilities (like parks or cafes) nearby. **Answer:** Dear Cousin, I am so excited about my new flat in the city centre! We are currently putting a new grey armchair in the living room and hanging curtains in the kitchen. The flat has two bedrooms and a very modern bathroom. My new neighbourhood is great because there is a small bakery next door and a beautiful park across the street. **Question 2 (Life in the City & Country):** Compare the traditional breakfast in a rural village with the fast-paced breakfast culture in a big city. Include why their habitats are important and what the consequences will be if we do not act now. **Answer:** Dear Friends, we must act now to save endangered animals like the Bengal Tiger. Their habitats, the tropical forests, provide oxygen and balance for our entire planet. If we continue to destroy these forests for wood and land, these beautiful animals will disappear forever.
