Uniformed and Emergency Services (L4) Overview

Who is this course for?

This course is open to all.

It is particularly appropriate for those wishing to learn about career options within the Uniformed and Emergency Services.

It is also a great option for those wishing to develop their employability skills.

What is involved in the course?

This course has been designed to provide candidates with opportunities to develop generic employability skills in the context of the uniformed and emergency services. The course may also assist progression into further education and training/employment in the uniformed and emergency services sector. The sector includes the emergency services, armed forces and commercial uniformed organisations such as the Merchant Navy. The course will allow candidates to start to develop the general and practical skills, knowledge and understanding and employability skills needed to work in the sector. The relevant uniformed services for this course are: The Army, Merchant Navy, Royal Air Force, Royal Navy and Royal Marines. The relevant emergency services for this course are: The Ambulance Service, Coastguard, Fire and Rescue and Police. Candidates will get the opportunity to work with a range of partners both within and out with Fortrose Academy.

Assessment(s)?

Four mandatory units must be completed:

- Health, Safety, Fitness & Wellbeing
- Engaging in the Community
- Working in Teams

Candidates must pass all outcomes and units. These will be completed on an ongoing basis through the SQA booklets.
