

ParisDotComm Ed.2 2023 - organisation report

Event summary

ParisDotComm 2023 is an innovative 3-day blockchain conference held at the "Institut du Monde Arabe" in Paris, France, focused on promoting the Polkadot ecosystem, fostering collaboration, and showcasing real-world applications of blockchain technology. The event features two stages, panel discussions, project presentations, workshops, an NFT exhibition, and networking opportunities for professionals and enthusiasts in the blockchain industry.

Event overview

The venue

"The Arab World Institute was designed to create some strong and durable cultural ties while cultivating constructive dialogue between the Arab World, France, and Europe." It is now a high place of cultural exchange in Paris, with many partnerships but is also very active in the domain of mathematics.

Our vision is to create a collaborative and inclusive platform that bridges the gap between the blockchain community, the web community and a broader non technical public. By emphasizing the Polkadot ecosystem and promoting usage of blockchain technology in people's everyday life, we aim to foster innovation, inspire new ideas, and encourage meaningful partnerships. Ultimately, our vision is to accelerate the adoption and understanding of blockchain technology, enabling a future where it becomes an integral part of our digital lives, economy, and society.

Why organize ParisDotComm during ETHCC in Paris?

- Synergy: Hosting both events in the same city and at the same time will create a synergy effect, where attendees interested in blockchain technology can benefit from attending both events. This may lead to more networking opportunities, collaboration, and knowledge sharing.
- Attracting a larger audience: ETHCC is a world top3 blockchain event. Since both
 events focus on the blockchain industry, attendees find it more convenient and
 cost-effective to attend both conferences, thus attracting a larger audience for both
 events.
- Greater visibility: Hosting ParisDotComm during ETHCC may increase the visibility of our event as more blockchain enthusiasts and professionals will be in Paris at that time.

- All figures are listed in a spreadsheet available on demand.
- PDotComm ASBL has been subject to a tax audit following the payment of some invoices. Negotiations took place with the authorities over a period of 3 months. For more information about this, please contact us in private.

✓ Initial Bounty Request:

Amount initially requested: 355,257€ (74.917 DOTs) to finance all the event. We received **60.199 DOTs** (~268.011€).

✓ Other Incomes:

We still had 44.164,19€ available from the previous year.

We raised 9123€ thanks to the sponsorship.

Total cumulative hours of work: ~780 hours

As a community event, the organization team members have agreed to apply a lower rate than the market rate of 60€/hour to avoid a heavy weight on the event budget.

Total amount for organizers work = 46800 €

It is up to the bounty team to consider a reward for the organizing team.

Paris is a good place to organize blockchain events. However, with competition from ETHCC and all the other events around it, it might be useful to think about other options for the future: another venue, another moment...? But there's no doubt that this edition of ParisDotComm left a positive mark on the blockchain community.


The year 2024 will be special because Paris is organizing the Olympic Games. ETHCC will be organized in Brussel and Polkadot Decoded is happening at the same time.

For these reasons, there will be no organization of ParisDotComm in 2024. Let's see what will be possible in 2025...




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
