Our **Integrated Liberal Studies - Preparatory** courses introduce students to the WTSOA digital learning environment, develop competencies in **study skills, time management, written and oral communication skills, critical thinking, technical skills, and interpersonal skills**. We use themes about people, cultures, and geography of world regions as the content around which to build these skills. We use a daily small group webcam class (4-6 students) for instruction and guided study sessions. **Consistency and repetition of effective learning tasks** help students to be successful with future online courses.

HS Integrated Liberal Studies (ILS)

**Wings to Soar Online Academy is registered in the state of WI but is not accredited at this time.*

We recommend HS students register with Home Life Academy to take advantage of their name recognition and their expert help with transcripts and college recommendation letters.

High School Integrated Liberal Studies (ILS) give wide exposure to a range of subjects/themes that help students see the relationships between social studies, the arts, literature, and science. Our ILS program develops competencies in written and oral communication skills, critical thinking and analysis, technical skills, and interpersonal skills at the 8-10th grade skill level and the 10-12th grade level

HS ILS Sequence: Four-year topic rotation

- English component: Expanded Paragraphs, Basic and Advanced Essays (Six Traits), Literature analysis to support Social Studies content, vocabulary (WW), spelling, and writing mechanics.

ILS Non-Western History, Geography, & Culture	9th-10th	2 credits per year - combining Social Studies, History, English, and related electives. One additional credit for Study Skills/English is available.

Group Class: Group classes meet three times per week online via webcam for group discussion and guided learning with instructors and a small group (4-9) of classmates.

HS (9th-12th) - Mon and Tues

MS (6th-9th) - Mon and Tues
12:30-1:25 pm Central with group
guided study Wed 12:30-1:15

Work Expectations: All students are required to complete daily assignments (homework) and attend all group classes. Daily required homework expectations:

- HS ILS:**
 - 45-60 minutes social studies,
 - 45-60 minutes Lit & Comp,
 - 45-60 minutes daily for spelling, vocabulary, language, reading
- MS ILS:**
 - 45 minutes social studies,
 - 45 minutes Lit & Comp,
 - 45-60 minutes daily for spelling, vocabulary, language, reading
