Instructions for the Personal Instance setup

Hello. We appreciate your patience. We are implementing private instances of Local Viking.

What defines someone as an Agency?

You are an **Agency**, if you manage other businesses Google My Business listings as part of your own business's services.

You are a **Small/Medium Business** if you only manage your own business Google My Business listing.

There is **no additional cost** for using the Google My Business api nor is there any additional costs for setting up the private local viking instance and using the white-label features. All pricing will remain the same.

Step 1

1: If you are an a **Small/Medium Business**,
Fill out the Internal LV Private Instance Request Form

If you are an **Agency** please continue on with the steps.

Step 2

3A: If you are an Agency, Apply for a Google API.

Do not call your project "Local Viking" or any variation along those lines. Whatever your project is titled, make sure it does not have the word viking.

Fill out the Google API Request Form at P.S when you apply use an email for an allowlist request form with your domain name on your website

Step 4

4: If you are an Agency, Designate a Subdomain.

For example, if your website is listing-manager.com, you might designate gmb.listing-manager.com as a subdomain.

You will need to set a CNAME record for that subdomain, which is wl.localbusinessreporting.com.

If you are with <u>Godaddy</u>, follow these steps to set your CNAME up
If you are with <u>NameCheap</u>, follow these steps to set your CNAME up
If you are with <u>Cloudflare</u>, follow these steps to set your CNAME up
If you are with <u>Squarespace</u>, follow these steps to set your CNAME up
If you are with another registrar, please go to <u>Google</u> and search "how to add a cname for **Insert Name of Registrar**" You will be given instructions on how to set a CNAME record up.

Please note, after adding a CNAME record and specifying your white label configuration, it can take up to 2-3 hours while the DNS records refresh (although 20 minutes is more typical)

If you want to check if your CNAME was properly set up correctly go <u>here</u>, type in the subdomain you picked. Click this <u>image</u> to see the correct setup.

Step 5

After you Create Subdomain go back to https://console.cloud.google.com
Use the same project that you used for the application of API
Complete the **Oauth Consent** steps.


