



Title: Grade Level Academic Data Review - Follow-up Meeting

Outcome: To assist grade-level teams in utilizing a problem-solving process to analyze data as necessary to improve student outcomes

Audience: Building Implementation Team, MTSS Coach, Grade Level Teams

Instructions: Utilize this outline to record current and previous student performance, review progress toward goals, adjust strategies or discuss new strategies if needed, and move students in and out of various intervention groups.
