

CHABOT COVID PROTOCOL CHEAT SHEET FOR FAMILIES - 4/28/22

These protocols are changing often and can sometimes be difficult to track; this document will be updated as needed - please keep in good communication about your students' health.



THE BIG 3 - How All Families can help keep our school safe and operational! PLEASE DO THE FOLLOWING AS SOON AS POSSIBLE

1. **REGISTER [FOR PRIMARY](#)** - Testing Agency and the location where all at home rapid tests need to be uploaded - *thank you to the 95% of families who have done this*
2. **REGISTER FOR [CONCENTRIC](#)** using this access code:OAKL-CHABOT - they are currently providing our POOLED TESTING and the in school rapid tests. If you consent to rapid, but do not want to participate in pooled testing please inform Margaret and your teacher - *thank you to the 80% of families who have done this*
3. If your child is fully vaccinated, please **upload a photo of their vaccine card** and send it to Margaret.Thorp@ousd.org; thanks to families who have sent these already!

What to do if your child has ANY symptoms:

As of January 12, Covid Symptoms refer to:

- ***Fever of 100F (37.8C) or higher or chills; Cough; Sore throat***
- ***Loss of taste or smell. Children may say that food "tastes bad" or "tastes funny".***
- ***Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath***
- ***Vomiting/Nausea or Diarrhea***
- ***Runny Nose; Fatigue or body aches; Headache***

1. DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL

2. Record in [Parent Square](#)

3. Email your teacher AND ALL OF THE FOLLOWING: . Ms. Pricilla <attendance@chabotelementary.org>, jessica.cannon@ousd.org, Breana.Townsend@ousd.org

4. Get a COVID test as soon as possible - [OUSD TESTING SITES](#) - walk ins are fine
*** **NEGATIVE AT HOME RAPID TESTS** are now sufficient to clear symptoms - you need to **REPORT THE RESULTS IN PRIMARY (OR EMAIL health.wellness@ousd.org) and send a photo of the results with name of tested person visible in the photo (written on the test itself, or on a paper nearby) and the date the test was administered** to ALL OF THE FOLLOWING: Ms Pricilla<attendance@chabotelementary.org>, jessica.cannon@ousd.org, Breana.Townsend@ousd.org

5. Student can return to school with a negative test once symptoms have improved - no fever for at least 24 hours - or after 10 days with no test

Absences due to Symptoms are excused. Work can be provided.

What to do if your child tests positive:

1. **DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL**
2. Record in [Parent Square](#)
3. Email your teacher (if you're comfortable with that) AND ALL OF THE FOLLOWING: margaret.thorp@ousd.org. Ms Pricilla attendance@chabotelementary.org, jessica.cannon@ousd.org
4. Student must isolate for at least 5 days (**Day 0 = the first day of symptoms or the day a positive test was taken, whichever came first**)
5. Student can return to school after 5 days if symptoms have improved, no fever for 24 hours and they have a NEGATIVE RAPID TEST taken on or after Day 5
*** **NEGATIVE AT HOME RAPID TESTS** are now sufficient to return to school after a POSITIVE - you need to REPORT THE RESULTS IN PRIMARY (OR EMAIL health.wellness@ousd.org) and send a photo **and send a photo of the results with name of tested person visible in the photo (written on the test itself, or on a paper nearby) and the date the test was administered to** of the results to ALL OF THE FOLLOWING: margaret.thorp@ousd.org. Ms Pricilla <attendance@chabotelementary.org>, jessica.cannon@ousd.org
6. Student can return on Day 11 **with no test** as long as symptoms have improved and no fever for 24 hours
7. Remove any child who tested positive from the pooled testing program - positives can show up in PCRs for up to 90 days after infection

Students home due to COVID will receive work and be placed on Independent Study.

What to do if your child has prolonged close contact with a confirmed positive:

As of 4/25/2022, quarantine is no longer required for exposed individuals, regardless of vaccination status or masking at the time of exposure. Exposed individuals are encouraged to test between days 3-5 following exposure, wear a mask around others for 10 days, and to isolate immediately if symptoms appear or they test positive for COVID.

This is true for exposures at school, home, or in community.
