Science: WEATHER

Keep track of the weather in your neighborhood (temperature, sunny/cloudy/rainy or any other weather information). Once you collect the data, create a graph to show your data. Feel free to include pictures of the weather.

Social Studies: RULES

Go outside and listen closely. What do you hear? Sketch and write about what you hear.

Help your family cook a meal. Pay close attention to the different ingredients that you use and how they come together to make a delicious meal.
