<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Science: WEATHER</u></b></p> <p>Keep track of the weather in your neighborhood (temperature, sunny/cloudy/rainy or any other weather information). Once you collect the data, create a graph to show your data. Feel free to include pictures of the weather.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Social Studies: RULES</u></b></p> <p>We have rules that we follow at school. What are the rules at your school? Do you have any rules at home? Make a poster for each of your rules and hang them up in your house.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Science: OBSERVE</u></b></p> <p>Go outside and listen closely. What do you hear? Sketch and write about what you hear.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Social Studies: INTERVIEW</u></b></p> <p>Find a family member or a friend that you would like to know more about. Create a list of questions to ask them. Look closely. What do you notice? What are you wondering? What does this photograph make you think?</p>

Pay close attention to the different ingredients that you use and how they come together to make a delicious meal.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Social Studies: TIMELINE</u></b></p> <p>Think about the major events in your life. Create a timeline of your life so far. Add pictures to make it come to life. These pictures could be sketches or actual photographs from your life.</p>
