School Schedule

Full-Time Students:

LGL meets four days a week, Monday through Thursday, from 9:00am-2:00pm and starts in September and goes through May.

Part-Time Students:

Once you choose the course you want your child to take, they will come twice a week. Courses offered are ELA, Science, History, Math Lab and Art and will be on a M/W or T/Th schedule.

We take off one week for Fall Break, one week for Thanksgiving, about two weeks for Christmas and one week for Spring Break. An official calendar will be sent out with the LGL contract.

Tuition

Full-Time Students:

Tuition is \$950/month for nine months for the 2025-2026 school year. If you are in need of financial assistance with tuition, please indicate this on your application.

Part-Time Students:

Each course is \$200/month. Students enrolled in more than one course receive a 15% discount.

Place Holder Fee - \$950

Once your child is accepted, you will sign the LGL contract and pay a \$950 Place Holder fee that will be applied toward that year's May tuition. If you break the contract and decide to withdraw from LGL during the school year, the Place Holder Fee will not be refunded.

Supply Fee - \$100

There is a \$100 yearly supply fee due with the contract that covers items such as paper, ink, craft/school supplies and holiday party supplies.
