

Episode 441 Script

Welcome back to Yang Daily! I'll be your host, Alex Chaney, bringin' you all the Yang news you need to live your life right. Sorry for being late! I've had to do birthday shopping for 3 people at once, and they're not easy to buy for. Then there's the deluge of Yang news going on and, as you know, I'm not good at calling a stop to an episode's topics when there's more to go, so we've got a longer episode! Tomorrow will be mostly UBI news. For today, there's action on the debt ceiling, the Forward Party, and RCV. Let's get into it.

Shout-out to our Tier 3 Patrons, Shae Meehan and Nathan Stankowski, as well as all our other Patrons! You keep us all informed and engaged. It would only take a couple bucks a month from each listener to keep this podcast and community going and growing! On to the news!

-First off, the debt ceiling crisis has been delayed. In face of the GOP blocking a debt ceiling raise, and Manchin & Friends refusing to alter the filibuster, Democratic leadership got Manchin's grudging cooperation to delay the debt ceiling fight until December, when they plan to stuff it into the reconciliation bill, right alongside the kitchen sink. I was just thinking we needed more riding on that piece of legislation.

GOP leadership has vowed to allow the U.S. to default on its debt, rather than work with Democrats. The debt ceiling has been raised dozens of times. It is used by the minority party as a threat, to obstruct the party in power and extract compromises. Trump, as always, says the quiet part out loud, saying of McConnell, quote: "He's got all the cards with the debt ceiling, it's time to play the hand." End quote. The debt ceiling pretty much does nothing but facilitate obstruction.

-Next, we're back to Forward Party business. The website has been fleshed out. It now has missions statements, policies, FAQ, etc.. So, let's see what we can learn. First, we have a couple mission statements that reinforce it will be more of an advocacy group than a party. I'm skipping some fluff bits here. Quote:

"We need to push for open primaries and ranked-choice voting in Congressional races around the country... This is an inclusive movement. You can participate while retaining your current party registration if you'd like, as we know that in many locations de-registering would effectively disenfranchise you from your local politics. Forward is positive and practical. We believe in people of every political alignment that want to help the country.

We will support candidates for office who align with our core principles so that we can reform the system and make it more responsive to the American people. This means that we will support Republicans, Democrats, and Independents - as well as candidates identifying themselves as Forward Party members.

We will also work with organizations that are promoting democracy reform in order to promote policies such as Ranked-Choice Voting, Open Primaries, and easier ballot access for third parties." End quote.

Then we have some answers to what we really want to know, courtesy of the frequently asked questions section. Quote:

"Will the Forward Party support or run candidates?

Yes, the Forward Party will support candidates for offices from the local to the national. If you are a candidate who agrees with the Forward Party's core principles, you can apply for support here. We will support candidates running as Democrats, Republicans, Independents, and any other party who supports our goals, starting with Open Primaries and Ranked-Choice Voting.

Are you concerned that the Forward Party will just be a spoiler?

...due to the current electoral process, in the vast majority of races the Forward Party will be involved in, the candidate is likely to be running as a member of one of the major parties."

So, they will "support" candidates, mostly from the duopoly (and, due to current GOP stances on democracy, mostly Democrats), as well as a few independents. As expected. Now for the concerning one. Quote:

"Will there be a Forward candidate for President in 2024?

It's too soon to tell, but if there is demand for a third party candidate, the Forward Party may look to address it. The Forward Party may hold its own primary process to nominate a candidate." End quote.

This one is straight poison. The number one thing that can doom the Forward Party is Democrats thinking it will get Trump re-elected. This answer does NOT dispel that fear. How it *should* read is "We are not currently planning to run a presidential candidate. We will reconsider, if RCV or another non-plualistic voting scheme is adopted." That is what it needs to say.

I get wanting to retain the option, because maybe Democrats try running Biden, with an approval rating of "go F yourself," making a 3rd party Yang run the only hope of defeating Trump. It's all too possible. But, as Yang himself says, 3rd party winning the presidential is not realistic with the current rules. Even though most Americans would prefer Yang to Trump, the anti-3rd party barriers in the election system would probably give Trump the win anyway.

On the other hand, anything that leaves the door open to Forward being a spoiler is going to sink this effort right to the bottom of the ocean, if it hasn't already. We need to get them to change this and get Yang to be definitive about it every time he talks about the party. Message

Next we have the guiding principles, which all candidates will have to promote. These are:
Ranked-Choice Voting and Open Primaries,
Fact-Based Governance,
Human-Centered Capitalism,
Effective and Modern Government,
UBI, and
Grace and Tolerance.
There's a description for each but they don't add much specificity. But, there's also the policy list, which currently consists of:
The American Scorecard,
Term Limits,
Ranked Choice Voting,
Open Primaries,
Independent Redistricting Commissions,
Data Rights,
Ban on Revolving Door for Politicians,
Citizen's Portal,

Department Of Technology,

Automatic Tax Filing,

Democracy Dollars,

American Exchange Program,

Civic Juries, and

Accessible and Secure Voting.

So, mostly democracy reforms. A couple oddities in there, like Data Rights and Automatic Taxes. We don't have time to go over the details for them today – we'll do that another time – but I will mention that their definition of "open primaries" is, quote: "...everyone who wants to run for a given office enters the same primary, and the top vote getters move on to the general election. Candidates can identify with a party or not." End quote. In other words, jungle primaries, plus ranked-choice voting.

-Andrew's been making serious rounds to promote the party and his book. In just the last few days he's been on CNN multiple times - with Anderson Cooper, Don Lemon, Reality Check, and Wolf Blitzer - on Good Morning America, The Young Turks, the Sam Harris and Karen Hunter podcasts, even on Fox, with Tucker Carlson. I think my personal favorite was the informal interview with the Fung Bros., though Karen Hunter is also great, as far as I've gotten through it, just as her previous interview of Yang was.

What was most disappointing around these was people blithely writing Yang off in the comments, for one superficial reason or another, and, particularly, on the Tucker interview. Pretty dominant Twitter comments trying to cancel Yang just for going there, much as when he did the same during the presidential race. It's fundamentally absurd and demonstrative of the tribalism Yang is looking to mitigate. You don't change anything by hiding in echo chambers and complaining to your clones. If you want to make progress in a democracy, you have to convince the people who disagree with you. And if you want to do that, you have to speak to them. We should want those people hearing MORE reasonable perspectives, not less.

What was most *surprising* was the host of CNN's Reality Check being allowed to express a lot of sympathy for a 3rd party. He gave a great review of the facts around the viability of 3rd parties

and Independents, how they often work within the duopoly, and how its a very different situation running state and local races as independent or 3rd party vs presidential.

Otherwise, the cable appearances were very brief and nothing new. I haven't made it through the podcasts yet, but all the interview links are below, if you're interested.

-Finally, for today, I'm pleased to announce that a bill called The Voter Choice Act has been introduced to Congress, which would provide \$40 million in federal grants to cover up to 50% of the cost, along with other assistance, for switching to ranked-choice voting, for local and state governments that choose to do so. Basically, the same thing that's in the Freedom to Vote Act, but standalone. I'd prefer it include approval and STAR voting too but, I'll take it. Let your representatives know your thoughts.
