

2024 LCGC Winter Meeting Minutes

1. Election/approval of Officers no new applicants, and all officers are continuing in their position.
2. Treasury report – Dennis shared his report and it was discussed in relation to dues for 2024, plus all felt it was important to keep a balance in the ball park of \$1000, and we are just under that number.
3. Dues for 2024- dues for 2024 will be \$50, the same amount they were for 2023. Those members due a refund (\$10) from the September outing will be notified, and will only pay \$40 this year.
4. Finalize tournament formats – tournament formats were discussed, with changes being made to three months – April, May and September. We be doing a scramble for the April Outing at Iron Valley. Details can be found on the Tournament Format, Scoring and Prizes page.
5. Finalize thoughts on CTP – We will split Closest to the Pin each outing into two holes for Forward tee players, and two holes for Regular tee players. If a course has 5 par threes, we will still play the 2 & 2 format. A decision will be made prior to each outing which holes will be used. Prize money will be based on the number of participants entered for each group.
6. Club Championship: We will divide the field into three flights, keeping each group as even as possible, but also paying attention to the indexes if the players in each group. The top two net scores (1st and 2nd place) in each group will be paid. In cases of a tie, cards will be matched by starting with the #1 handicap and proceeding until the tie is broken. **The winners in each group will match cards to determine the overall winner.** That individual will have his dues paid for the next season.
7. Presidents Cup: It was felt (and mentioned for opinion in the fall of 2023) that interest had waned in the President's Cup, and while the group likes match play, we felt it was important to include the May outing as a paying event. The May outing will now be the 3-2-1 format. We also will stop tracking President's Cup points from this point forward.
8. Contracts: Pretty straight forward – if we are asked to sign a contract, the contact committee person will consult the League President (no change here), and in addition, a contract must have the green's fee for that event listed.
9. Recommend keeping the **low net season-long contest.** We will pay the top four places.
10. The charter by-laws, which had been sent out to the group for discussion (actually 1 ½ years ago) were discussed and changed/updated where needed. The updated version is available on our website
