Temple Construction Progress Report (current as of 1/1/22)

Preliminary Notes: The Church has **265** temples in various phases. Of those, **170** are currently operating. Opening arrangements have been announced for **1** other temple, with **2** more completed and nearing completion (all of which could have opening arrangements announced in the next 2-4 months). An additional **10** are anticipated to be dedicated in the next year, while **26** additional temples are in various phases of construction. Additionally, full-scale construction is pending for **4** more temples.

A total of **11** previously-dedicated temples are in various stages of renovation. That includes **1** for which reopening arrangements have been announced, **2** more completed temples for which reopening arrangements have been delayed due to COVID-19; and **1** other temple is anticipated to have its' renovation completed by the end of this year or early next year (and may not require a rededication). **2** others are anticipated to be completed between 2022 and 2023. **3** of the **4** pioneer-era temples are also closed for renovation (the Logan Utah Temple is anticipated to begin its' renovation within the next 12-18 months). Plans to reconstruct **1** other temple (in Provo Utah) have been announced as well.

The Church has set a groundbreaking for **1** more temple, and there are a minimum of **19** other temples for which groundbreaking announcements are pending. The announcement of official details is pending for **10** additional temples. The remaining **21** temples are announced.

Thus far in his prophetic administration, President Nelson has announced 83 new temples. Recent statements from apostles (including and especially President Nelson himself) have noted that the total number of temples will increase ten-fold.

With no signs of slowing down, the Church could reach the milestone of 200 operating temples before, by, or shortly after the April 2024 General Conference. Recent anecdotal evidence further suggests that the prophet may be looking at trying to get 70 more temples dedicated within the next 5 years.

Since that would bring the total number of operating temples to nearly 240 by early-to-mid 2026, it does not seem to be a stretch to conclude that the number of operating temples by the 200th anniversary of the Church's reestablishment could rise to 300, especially in view of innovations that will be able to decrease the length of time and costs to construct each temple.

With 8.26 years within which to dedicate those remaining 130 temples, the Church could achieve that goal if roughly 15.74 temples are dedicated each full year during now and then. Between now and the end of 2022, anywhere between 11-16 temples could be dedicated, and if temple construction accelerates as it seems to be on track to do, that potential revised goal (300 by the 200th anniversary of the Church) could easily be met, if not exceeded.

Taylorsville Utah Temple: Assembling the pedestal for the steeple; cladding revealed at northeast corner; sheathing damp-proofed; dedication could occur sometime during *mid-2023*. *192.* Urdaneta Philippines Temple: Cladding of exterior progressing; interior work underway; dedication could occur sometime during *mid-2023*.

193. Puebla Mexico Temple: Cupola frame added; installing roof deck; attaching vapor barrier to exterior concrete walls; dedication could occur sometime during *mid-to-late 2023*.

194. Brasilia Brazil Temple: Cladding the exterior in stone; hardscaping of the grounds underway; dedication could occur sometime during *mid-to-late 2023*.

195. Salta Argentina Temple: Steeple frame installed; framing interior; installing windows; dedication could occur sometime during *mid-to-late 2023*.

196. Red Cliffs Utah Temple: Exterior cladding underway; interior framing progressing; dedication could occur sometime during *late 2023*.

197. San Pedro Sula Honduras Temple: Parapet added to tower walls; dedication could occur sometime during *late 2023*.

<u>Preliminary Note:</u> It has been customary in recent years for the Church to release official details about new US temples beginning 2 months after each General Conference. The 4 US temples announced in October 2021 may have details announced between December 2021-April 2022 *236*. Rexburg North Idaho Temple: Planning and approval phase; site reportedly acquired (awaiting official confirmation); official details anticipated to be announced anytime between *January-April 2022*.

237. Fort Worth Texas Temple: Planning and approval phase; official details anticipated to be announced anytime between *January-April 2022*.

238. Cody Wyoming Temple; Planning and approval phase; official details anticipated to be announced anytime between *January-April 2022*.

239. Heber Valley Utah Temple: Planning and approval phase; official details anticipated to be announced anytime between *January-April 2022*.

240. Kumasi Ghana Temple: Planning and approval phase; site location confirmation pending; exterior rendering of the Kumasi Ghana Temple presented to the King of Ghana on December 1, 2021; official details could be announced in *January-April 2022*.

241. Managua Nicaragua Temple: Planning and approval phase; site acquired (awaiting official confirmation); official details anticipated to be announced in *March-June 2022*.

244. Dubai United Arab Emirates Temple: Planning and approval phase; site location unknown; Elder Bednar visited the general temple location in late October 2021; official details anticipated to be announced in *August-October 2022*.

245. Sao Paulo East Brazil Temple: Planning and approval phase; awaiting official site announcement; official details anticipated to be announced in *August-October 2022*. <u>Note:</u> A short time after this temple was announced, someone living near Sao Paulo Brazil mentioned on the Church Growth blog that this temple could potentially be built in Guarulhos, Santo André, or Diadema. Additionally, in mid-to-late October 2021, Elder Ulisses Soares had a 10-day ministry in Sao Paulo Brazil.
