

## Art Styles & Masterpieces"

### 1. Warming-up

Використайте метод "**Visual Thinking**". Покажіть учням дві контрастні картини (наприклад, реалістичний портрет та абстракцію Кандінського).



### 2. Абстракція (Василь Кандіський)

Тут замість реальних об'єктів ми бачимо гру геометричних фігур, ліній та яскравих кольорів, які передають емоції та музикальність, а не фізичний світ.



### Ідеї для обговорення (Questions for students):

1. **Focus on Detail:** In which painting can you see clear details like eyes or hair? In which one do you see only shapes?
2. **Colors:** Describe the colors in the first painting (natural, calm). Now look at the second one (vibrant, energetic). How do they change your mood?
3. **Meaning:** If the portrait tells a story of a real person, what story does the abstract painting tell? Is it a feeling, a sound, or a dream?
4. **Vocabulary:** Use words like *blurry*, *sharp*, *geometric*, *lifelike*, *imaginary*.

### Questions:

1. Which painting do you like more? Why?

2. How do these paintings make you feel? (Happy, confused, calm, energetic?)

3. What do you think the artists wanted?

Style	Description	Famous Artist
<b>Realism</b>	Depicts subjects as they appear in everyday life.	Gustave Courbet
<b>Impressionism</b>	Focuses on light and thin brushstrokes.	Claude Monet
<b>Cubism</b>	Uses geometric shapes to represent objects.	Pablo Picasso
<b>Surrealism</b>	Features dream-like, strange, and illogical scenes.	Salvador Dalí
<b>Abstract Art</b>	Does not represent reality; uses colors and forms.	Wassily Kandinsky

#### 4. Reading & Matching

**Instruction for students:** Read the descriptions of these famous masterpieces. Can you identify the art style for each one? Use the vocabulary from our lesson.

##### *Painting 1: "The Starry Night" by Vincent van Gogh*

In this painting, the artist does not try to show the world exactly as it looks. Instead, he uses short, thick brushstrokes that look like waves in the sky. The yellow stars and the moon seem to be moving or "shaking." The light is the most important part of the picture. Everything looks a bit blurry, as if the artist wanted to capture a quick moment of a dream.

##### *Painting 2: "The Weeping Woman" by Pablo Picasso*

When you look at this portrait, the face looks very strange. It is broken into many different parts. You can see the eyes, the nose, and the mouth from different angles at the same time. The artist used sharp geometric shapes like triangles and squares.

It doesn't look like a real person, but you can clearly feel the woman's pain through these broken forms.

### *Painting 3: "The Persistence of Memory" by Salvador Dalí*

This painting looks like a scene from a dream that makes no sense. In a realistic desert, you can see clocks that are melting like soft cheese. Everything is painted very clearly and realistically, but the objects themselves are impossible in real life. It is logical and illogical at the same time, showing us the world of the human subconscious.
