- Remember that in Spanish if it's a question, we have an upside down question mark right before the question (same with exclamation mark). Also, accent marks (the "slash" above vowels) are ONLY over vowels and are important because they could change the word if you do not have it there. For example: si (if) does NOT mean si (yes) Would you answer "if" for the question: Do birds fly? (IF) would not be right
