B - Terminology	I have used economic terms throughout the IA	
2 marks	I have used economic terms correctly	
C - Application & analysis	I selected economic theory relevant to the article	
3 marks	I have adapted the economic theory to the specifics of the article	
	Throughout my analysis and evaluation I am referring to the specific situation of the article (for example instead of saying producers, if the article is about farmers, say farmers)	
	I have used economic theory to show impacts of an event	
	I have used terms such as: thus, and so, therefore, consequently, will lead to	
	I have tied in my analysis with my diagrams	
	My analysis is not simply repeating things in the article, nor is it too descriptive or sound like it comes straight from a textbook

	My analysis and discussion have strong connections with the key concept	
E - Evaluation	I have selected at least 2 of the following CLASPP evaluation points <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Conclusion ● Long and short term effects ● Assumptions ● Stakeholders ● Priorities ● Pro and Cons 	
3 marks	I am not repeating the conclusions of the article	
	I have provided a sophisticated evaluation (judgment) by considering multiple levels	
	I have written a conclusion	
	I have used terms such as: however, nevertheless, overall, even though	

Article selection	My article is less than a year old	
	My article is not written by an economist	
	My article is copied into my IA	
	My article has relevant sections highlighted	
	My article does not already contain too much economic analysis and evaluation
