Read the article. Why was James Dean famous?

REBEL, REBEL

James Byron Dean was born on 8th February 1931

In 1940, a year after his mother died, he moved to a small town called Fairmount, where he lived with his aunt and uncle. At school he acted in several plays; he even played the part of Frankenstein! When he left school in 1950, he studied at Santa Monica City College and waited patiently for his first acting part. Later that year it arrived: it was in a Pepsi advert and he only received \$30!

Over the next four years he lived on money from radio, theatre and television work. In April 1954, he signed a contract for his first big film, *East of Eden*. He spent the money he received on a sports car. James loved fast cars and started entering car racing competitions.



He laughed at his friends when they told him it was dangerous.

In 1955, he made two more films, *Rebel Without a Cause* and *Giant*. In both films James Dean played the part of a young rebel. Two years after he arrived in Hollywood, he was killed in a traffic accident near Paso Robles, California, on 30th September 1955. He was only 24 and his death was front page news.

James Dean was popular because in his films and in real life, he was the rebel many young people wanted to be. Indeed, he was so popular that a record released after his death called *His name was Dean* sold 25 000 copies in a week. Forty years later, young people still write to James Dean with their problems.

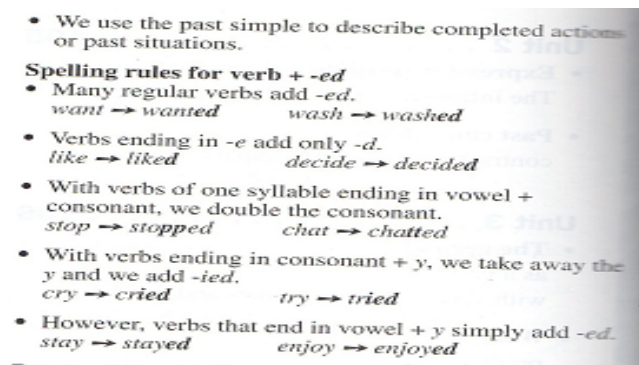
