A few things:

1. Please ensure you credit the photographer. The photo credit, if applicable, will be in the album title. Here is an example of how you would save your photo for future use: Charis Birchall - Spaces and Places detail - photo credit Amanda Yeoman Photography.jpg
2. It is your responsibility to keep these links somewhere handy. You could create a bookmark folder in your browser or simply save this email for future reference.
3. Or, go into the albums now, download **your** photos to your computer, then you never have to access these links again. I will send out new links when we have new photos from exhibitions.
4. To download a photo, click on the photo, click on the 3 little dots up on the right of the photo and then click "download". Here's the google help link for downloading photos. <https://support.google.com/photos/answer/7652919?hl=en>

2. The google photo album is accessible to members only and may not be shared.
3. Upon departure of the cooperative, outgoing members will no longer have access to the google photo album.
