



2026 Application for Susan Hillhouse Performing Arts Scholarship

The Susan Hillhouse Performing Arts Scholarship is a \$1,000-\$1,500 scholarship opportunity for enrolled and full-time college/university students who are pursuing a performing arts degree (major or minor) or an arts-related teaching degree (major or minor) and who intend to stay active in the arts after receiving their degree – either as a performer or teacher. One individual will be chosen per year. Students may apply for consecutive years (and students who previously received the scholarship may apply again for consideration).

Instructions:

- 1. Fill out the OCPAG Susan Hillhouse Performing Arts Scholarship Form.** (Click on “File”, then “Make a copy” in the menu. Then save the new file as your own.)
- 2. Submit one letter of recommendation** from a professor, teacher, or community performing arts leader to support your application.
- 3. Submit a current copy of your transcript** (an unofficial copy is fine)
