1.		herniation of medulla, reticular formation
2.		stroke affecting cerebellum
3.		amygdala hyperactivity caused by nearby tumor
4.		tumor affecting function of the hypothalamus
5.		stroke affecting right occipital lobe
6.		overstimulation of the sympathetic nervous system
7.		reduced functioning in frontal lobes
8.		tumor in left parietal lobe

Having sorted all of the patient files left by your predecessor, you now have new patients to examine. After reading each patient's file, provide a tentative diagnosis for the patient.
