



RPU: Car Sting Handbook

What is a Car Sting?

A car sting is performed by placing a Civilian vehicle in a hotspot of vehicle theft (Legion, Simeons, Casino). The car (civilian) will intentionally be left unlocked. Members of RPU will observe it in an unmarked vehicle. **(If you don't own an unmarked vehicle and wish to perform a Car sting, message RPU command, and we will be happy to auth for this purpose.)**

If a public member steals the vehicle, you will then pursue the vehicle with the usual tactics. Once the thief of the car is caught, he will be charged under ***Section 12, Theft Act 1968***, ensuring correct police procedures are followed whilst arresting the suspect.

Rules:

- Ensure it is a vehicle you can comfortably catch alone if required
- Do not entrap civilians into stealing vehicles (Yo bro, take this car, etc.)
- Only Perform Tactical contact in an unmarked vehicle if you are part of the Unmarked Patrol Force
- Any RPU member may conduct a car sting

Examples of a Car Sting:
