What are Behavior Modules?

SFUSD's Behavior Assessment & Intervention Team developed asynchronous learning modules for staff to introduce Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA), the science of understanding and changing behavior, and evidence-based practices. Staff may be able to request permission from their site administrator to complete modules for Prop G hours.

Module	Description	Links
BXM 1: Principles of Behavior (ABA 101)	<i>This training will review the foundations of Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA), which is the science of understanding and changing behavior.</i>	Slide Deck Video
BXM 2: Data Collection	<i>When implementing behavior change plans, staff must collect accurate data. Effective data collection systems allow staff to monitor the success of their intervention to inform future decisions.</i>	Slide Deck Video
BXM 3: Antecedent Interventions	<i>This training will teach staff how to adjust the environment to avoid challenging behavior. By identifying "triggers," staff can implement antecedent interventions to prevent misbehavior. (~1hr)</i>	Slide Deck Video
BXM 4: Functions of Behavior	<i>Understanding why behavior is happening is vital to changing behavior. In this training, we will review the 4 primary functions of behavior and discuss how to determine it through data collection.</i>	Slide Deck Video
BXM 5: Reinforcement Strategies	<i>In order to increase desired behaviors, staff must provide students with powerful reinforcement. This training will teach staff how to develop reinforcement plans to effectively acknowledge and increase appropriate behaviors.</i>	Slide Deck Video
BXM 6: Replacement Behaviors	<i>In order to change behavior, often a student needs to learn an alternate behavior to use instead. In this training, we will discuss how to develop and practice replacement behaviors based on function.</i>	Slide Deck Video
BXM 7: Prompting Strategies	<i>In this training, staff will learn about the hierarchy of prompting strategies that staff can use to encourage a student to engage in desired behaviors</i>	Slide Deck Video
BXM 8: Reading & Implementing a BIP	<i>Participants will learn how to read a Behavior Intervention Plan (BIP) with the purpose of implementing it within a school setting.</i>	Slide Deck Video
BXM 9: Autism & Evidence-Based Practices	<i>This training reviews evidence-based practices for students with autism.</i>	Slide Deck Video
BXM 9: Discrete Trial Training	<i>This module explains a teaching strategy that may be helpful to many Autistic learners.</i>	Slide Deck
BXM 11: Independent Work Stations	<i>This module helps teachers learn how to set up work stations where students can complete tasks independently (TEACCH stations)</i>	Slide Deck

Tier 1: Universal Classroom Supports Tier 1 Workbook	<i>Tier 1 supports are universal strategies that foster positive, predictable, consistent, and safe environments that will support the needs of most students. This training will review how to develop a classroom management plan (expectations, routines, acknowledgements systems, and responses to misbehavior).</i>	Classroom Mgmt Plan Session: Slide Deck General Classroom Tier 1: Slide Deck
Tier 2: Evidence-Based Behavior Interventions Tier 2 Workbook	<i>Some students need additional support, teaching, and/or reinforcement in order to thrive in a school setting. Tier 2 interventions are evidence-based programs to provide direct instruction, enhanced feedback and differentiated reinforcement. This training will review how to identify appropriate interventions, implement, and monitor progress.</i>	Slide Deck
Tier 2 - Enhanced: Individualized Behavior Interventions	<i>Tier 2 enhanced interventions are individualized plans that address a student's unique needs and environment. This training will teach staff how to develop a student plan based on the PTR Model: Prevent-Teach-Reward.</i>	Slide Deck
De-Escalation: Understanding, Preventing, & Responding to Challenging Behavior	<i>This training reviews the foundations of behavior to provide staff with a shared understanding of what contributes and maintains challenging behavior. You'll also learn strategies to prevent challenging behavior and ways to respond and de-escalate that align with Safety Care training. (~1hr)</i>	Slide Deck Video
