Our codes of conduct hold an important message about the proper role of parents, volunteers and players in our league. The essential elements of character building and ethics in sports are the foundations of sportsmanship and are demonstrated by the core principles of respect, responsibility, fairness, and good citizenship.

As a JYAA player I hereby pledge to the following code of conduct:

- I will show good sportsmanship to players, coaches, officials, opponents, and parents at every game and practice.
- I will learn the value of commitment by participating in as many practices and games as I can.
- I will encourage my teammates and praise good efforts.
- I will be honest, fair, and respectful to others at all times.
- I will aim to learn all I can from sports.
- I will arrive to practice/games on time and ready to dedicate my attention to my coaches.
- I understand that fighting, bullying, taunting or arguing of any kind will not be tolerated. Involved player(s) will be suspended pending investigation with possible removal from the league.

I also agree that if I fail to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines, I will be subject to disciplinary action levied by the Johnstown Youth Athletic Association Board Members that could include, but is not limited to the following:

- Verbal Warning
- Written Warning
- Game Suspension
- Season Suspension
- League Removal
