



Discussion Questions/Activities/Challenges

1. Consider the many communities that you are part of. What can you, as an individual do, to make your community a better place for everyone? What can you do together with your class, your school, your family or other groups of likeminded people do to make positive change in your community?
2. What happens when you help others? Consider the impact on those you are helping, but also think about how you feel after you have done something good for someone else.
3. If you were to start an A-Team at your school, think about what your team of Angels could do to spread kindness and positivity among the students and staff at your school.
4. Think about who the angels in your life are. What makes them special? What are they doing to make the world a better place? Is there a way that you can follow their example?

Given that all the money raised by the Foundation goes right back to helping students and families in need in your own school, and throughout your school board, what could your class (or school) do to help raise awareness about the work of The Angel Foundation, and/or to help raise money?
