Planning the perfect party

Tell your guests when the party starts and when it will end. Also, let them know if they should wear a certain type of clothes (e.g. fancy dress).

You can use decorations, lighting and music to create the perfect party atmosphere. Choose your favourite music and play it at the background as your guests arrive. It is a good idea to remove your television if it is in the party area. You can also replace some of your light bulbs (лампочки) with coloured lamps.
