Matthew 14:22-33, Philippians 4:13

Matthew 14:22-33 New International Version

Jesus Walks on the Water(A)(B)

²⁵ Shortly before dawn Jesus went out to them, walking on the lake. ²⁶ When the disciples saw him walking on the lake, they were terrified. "It's a ghost," (D) they said, and cried out in fear. ²⁷ But Jesus immediately said to them: "Take courage!(E) It is I. Don't be afraid." (E)²⁸ "Lord, if it's you," Peter replied, "tell me to come to you on the water." ²⁹ "Come," he said. Then Peter got down out of the boat, walked on the water and came toward Jesus. ³⁰ But when he saw the wind, he was afraid and, beginning to sink, cried out, "Lord, save me!" ³¹ Immediately Jesus reached out his hand and caught him. "You of little faith," (G) he said, "why did you doubt?" ³² And when they climbed into the boat, the wind died down. ³³ Then those who were in the boat worshiped him, saying, "Truly you are the Son of God." (H)

Introduction

Take a broomstick and balance it on your hand. Ask one of the learners to do this. Blindfold the learner and ask him to balance the stick. It is only possible to balance the stick if you look at the tip of the stick.

Walk on water

We can apply this principle in our lives. If we keep our eyes fixed on Jesus, we will stand.

In the passage we read, Jesus walked on water. His disciples saw him and were very afraid. Jesus told them not to be afraid and to have courage. Peter then asked Jesus to command him to come to Him. Jesus then said, "come". Peter got out of the boat and walked up to him on the water. When he saw the big waves, he got scared and started sinking. Peter asks, "Lord save me".



Jesus held out his hand and saved Peter.

Peter did the impossible and walked on water. However, when Peter took his eyes off Jesus, he became afraid he began to sink.

With our eyes fixed on Jesus, we are capable of anything. With our eyes fixed on Jesus, we can face the onslaughts of life. With our eyes fixed on Jesus, we are capable of the impossible.

Even if we sometimes look away from Jesus and start to sink, Jesus is always there to help us.

Inleiding

Loop op water
