POL Notes Review + Plan

Purpose: For you to review the feedback you received at your POL, and to create a concrete plan to fill the gaps in your knowledge and research in the next phase of research.

Step 1: Review Feedback

Read over your notes from your POL- both those you were given by teachers, and those you took for yourself. Highlight, underline, mark up the most important things.

Step 2: Make a List of To-Dos + Feedback

In the assignment below, make a list of all the things that you need to do in the 2nd column (What do you need to do?). These should break down into the following categories (you may not have all of these, but you should have some):

- a. Research question revisions
- b. Terms you need to define
- c. Concepts or ideas you need to understand
- d. Types of evidence, sources, and information you need to find

In the first column, copy and paste the specific feedback that led you to this action item.

Step 3: Make a Plan

For each action item, write a specific plan or strategy you will use to address this feedback.

Possible actions here include, but are not limited to:

- 1. Revise research question based on feedback
- 2. Look through research articles for definitions, compile or decide on which to use and why
- 3. Read a wikipedia article about a specific concept/topic, and make notes OR verbally explain the concept to a teacher or thesis advisor
- 4. Ask ChatGPT or Claude for a summary of a concept, and make notes OR verbally explain
- 5. Find a source that fills in a research gap, and use it in your next stage of your annotated bibliography
- 6. Google a specific concept, and find what you need.
- 7. Talk to a teacher or your advisor to clarify a concept
- 8. Other?

This completed plan will be turned in with your Annotated Bibliography: Phase 2, with signatures showing you've completed each step.
