



iPad Distribution Schedule

In an effort to better meet the learning needs of our students, Cedars International Academy Schools will provide iPads to all students in grades PK-2. As before, the parent/student is financially responsible for negligent damages to the device.

Students in grades PK-2 will need to bring their currently issued devices to campus to receive their new iPads. The office will contact you to schedule an APPOINTMENT to pick up your device.

We also know that not all families have reliable internet access at home. We have a limited number of Wi-Fi hotspots for students without internet access at home to ensure continuing success in their remote learning. SAFETY MEASURE **BEFORE** PICKING UP A IPAD:

- Before picking up your iPad:
 - Complete the Device Loan Form for each child that needs an iPad.

 - Families must answer a self-screening questionnaire before leaving the home.

- If you receive a **YELLOW** OR **RED** SCREEN then we ask that you RESCHEDULE your appointment.
- If you have receive a **GREEN SCREEN** you should do the following:
 - Grab a face mask to wear
 - If you have a Chromebook to return, place it in a bag with the charger. Add the STUDENT FIRST AND LAST NAME AND GRADE LEVEL to the outside of the bag.
