Write one sentence that states the **Main Idea** of the article

Write 1-3 paragraphs with the supporting ideas and points made **in the article**. Any ideas that are not in the article but appear here will deduct 10 points from your final grade!!!

**ANALYSIS:**

Who is the person who wrote the article?

What is their background? Education?

How can I be sure I can trust them?

Have I fact checked the article?

How did I do that?

Who is the audience for the article?

What is the **tone** or style? Playful? Serious? Informative? Scholarly? Why is it written in this way?

**PERSONAL RESPONSE:**

What are my thoughts? Be specific – do not blandly praise the article

Did the article cover the important points? What are the important points?

Did the article represent the information fairly?

What is one thing the article states that you think is correct?

What is one thing you might change about the article?
