



Dear Parent or Guardian:

Springfield Public Schools receives the **Title VI Indian Education Formula Grant Program**, which is used to offer additional educational services for eligible Native American and Alaskan Native students.

The ED 506 form includes information about the grant. This form serves as the official record of the eligibility determination for each individual child included in the student count for the Title VI Indian Education Formula Grant Program. If you choose to submit a form, your child could be counted for funding under the program. Forms will be accepted anytime throughout the year.

To confirm whether your child is eligible, please complete this form and return it to your child's school office. Or, you may email the completed form to dlwhitham@spsmail.org. Forms must be completely filled out along with tribal membership information. Incomplete forms without membership information can not be processed.

We have used the grant to provide tutoring, college prep, resources to support cultural awareness, and additional counseling support to students.
