Course information

Year 9 Chinese offers a range of topics such as self-induction, family, hobbies, numbers, etc. to help students develop knowledge of basic Mandarin Chinese including pinyin, tones, essential vocabulary and phrases, common classroom expressions and simple sentence structures.

→ Goals

- Be able to introduce yourself and your family, your nationality, your age, talk about your hobbies, and ask and answer simple questions in Chinese.
- ◆ Be able to write about 70 Chinese characters.
- ◆ Be able to communicate in Chinese using everyday expressions.

→ To be successful in this course, you should:

- Participate actively in class
- complete Year 9 workbook and complete all the tasks assigned in Google Classroom for each topic.

Recommended prior learning Open entry.

Assessment in Years 9 - 11

All courses in Years 9 -11 are assessed using the Wellington College Learning Progressions Framework (LPF). There will be ongoing formative assessment, called 'checkpoints'. You will also be evaluated after each phase of learning, and your Learning Progression will be posted on the portal.
