- What is SEPAG
 - Every school district in NJ is required to have a SEPAG
 - Provide opportunity to community members to give direct input to the school district about policies, programs, practices and services that have an impact on students with disabilities and their families
 - Should be parent-driven and often is parent-led
 - Starts with creating a mission statement, annual goals and objectives, developing meeting schedule, and establishing ground rules

 - Why should we get involved?
 - Participation in a SEPAG offers the opportunity to raise questions, voice concerns, and provide direct input to district and school leadership. The individual needs of a child can become part of “the big picture,” and can reach a broader community of children.
