About the Position

The Research Assistant will work closely with **Dr. Lisa Meeks** and her research team on **grant-funded projects** examining disability inclusion, technical standards, and systemic barriers in medical and nursing education.

The Research Assistant will be engaged in **data analysis, literature reviews, manuscript preparation, and study coordination**, contributing to research that informs policy and institutional change. This individual will **oversee IRB submissions and manage multiple studies simultaneously, coordinating efforts across multiple investigators and learners.**

Key Responsibilities:

- Conduct literature reviews and synthesize findings.
- Assist with quantitative and qualitative data collection, data entry, and data cleaning.
- Support recruitment, screening, and consenting of research participants.
- Oversee Institutional Review Board (IRB) submissions and ensure compliance with ethical research standards.
- Manage multiple research studies simultaneously, coordinating across multiple investigators and learners.
- Prepare abstracts, reports, presentations, and manuscripts for publication.
- Collaborate with research partners and institutional stakeholders.
- Assist in maintaining research compliance and preparing IRB documents.
- Perform administrative and operational tasks related to research projects.
- Participate in team meetings and dissemination efforts.
