PROCEDURES FOR CAP & GOWN

- The main doors to the Conexus open 30 minutes before the ceremony at 6:30p.m.
- **If you or your guests require accessible seating, please notify Jessica Moser before June 16th.** You will need to arrive early and speak with a Conexus staff member, who will assist.
- There is no reserved seating.
- The ceremony will begin promptly at 7:00p.m.

Student Information

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION CAREFULLY.

1. **PICK UP YOUR GOWN on June 22 at 1:00.** Please note, **ALL** student fees must be paid and all library materials returned to receive your gown.
2. Arrive at the Conexus Arts Center **by 6:15p.m. BRING YOUR CAP and GOWN as there are no extras.**
3. Final details regarding the appropriate entrance and meeting area will be provided to graduates closer to the ceremony date.
4. Once you have put on your gown and cap, **line up alphabetically** in the area designated for your JAG.
5. Promptly at 7:00 p.m., you will be escorted to the auditorium. You will line up by JAG beginning with 12A. Your homeroom teacher will lead your JAG. Walk **quietly** to your seats on stage.
6. Once your name is called, you will walk on to the stage where **your JAG teacher** will hand you your diploma and pose for a photo. You will continue across the stage, and **Mr. Neuls** will move your tassel from left to right, and a picture taken. (Remember: receive with the left hand and shake with the right.)
9. The curtain will open, and you will be asked to stand and be presented as "F.W. Johnson Collegiate's 2025/2026 Graduating Class" to the audience.

Awards and Scholarships

F.W. Johnson has a Selection Committee that reviews applications from students who apply for the offered internal awards presented at the Cap & Gown. The internal scholarship link will be posted in the FWJ Post-Secondary Information Edsby group and will open at the beginning of May.

Regina Public Schools also provides a list of scholarships available for students. This is accessible through the FWJ Post-Secondary Information Edsby group.

Honour Roll

Honour roll is awarded to students with an average of 79.5% or higher based on all classes received from Regina Public Schools (including Campus Regina Public). Courses taken outside of Regina Public in grade 12 (including SaskDLC) will not be counted in honour roll calculations.

Valedictorian

At F.W. Johnson, the class valedictorian is nominated and voted on by the members of the graduating class. However, for the elected nominee to stand as valedictorian they must be in good academic standing and a positive member of the school community.
