<u>Did You Know?</u> • 95% of U.S. colleges accept the GED for entrance • There are Four Subjects Tested: Math, Science, Language Arts, Social Studies • Those with a high school diploma or GED earn more income over their lifetime.	<u>Frequently Asked Questions:</u> • What are GED tests: The General Educational Development tests (GED) measure the general knowledge and thinking skills needed to earn a high school diploma. • Why should I take the GED test? Most employers and colleges require a diploma or its equivalent for employment, promotion, or admission. • Who gives the GED test? The GED tests are given at the Abbeville Adult Ed Testing site, 400 Greenville St. • Who can take the GED test? Anyone who is at least 17 years of age, not enrolled in school, and who does not already have a high school diploma from an accredited school. • Will I be able to attend college with a GED? Yes. 95% of all colleges and universities accept the GED for enrollment.
<u>Abbeville Adult Education Offers Classes:</u> • GED preparation classes are offered Monday through Thursday from 9:00am to 12:00noon. • Classes and testing are held on the second floor of the District Office Building, 400 Greenville Street • Online instructional programs • Caring, certified teachers instruct the courses and personalize learning to students' needs • Childcare for preschool age children is provided while the parent is in class • Bus transportation is available within the city limits of Abbeville	
<u>Additionally:</u> • Basic Skills Classes are offered as well if you are not quite ready for the GED and need to brush up on basic skills. • Career planning is offered to help you explore the best path for your future. • Adult Education follows the district calendar for school closings and weather closings.	<u>GED Registration Requirements:</u> • Must be at least 17 yrs old and withdrawn from school • Must have a valid SC State Issued ID • Special accommodations must be submitted to PearsonVue for approval • Fees: \$37.50 per test. ** Students of Adult Education classes may receive a waiver for testing fees.
