OPAL: Fifty scouts from 18 states participated in a national department management workshop held at the Disaster Management Institute (MD) in collaboration with Indian Scout Guide chapter of the World Organization of the Scout Movement. The two-day workshop aims to prepare scouts for unforeseen disasters and help fellow citizens.

Addressing the scouts, DMI deputy director George V Joseph said that scouts play an important role in disaster management and relief work. "It is important for them to be updated about the techniques of the disaster," he said. The two-day workshop aims to prepare scouts for unforeseen disasters and help fellow citizens.



BEING READY: Over 50 scouts from across 18 states attended the workshop. They recently saw in case of Kerala floods. This workshop will help in understanding of what factors can lead to a disaster, how to avoid them and how to take necessary action in case of a disaster.

The scouts were also told about the psychological effects a disaster has upon the victims and their families.

"Families of the victims go into trauma after a disaster has struck. The shock sinks deep and the affects their behaviour. The scouts were taught ways to help them deal with the shock," said Prakash Disoriya, state organizing commissioner, scouting.
