- 13.00-13.45 NF1 neuroradiology meeting with a discussion of cases
- 13.45-14.30 Break and a visit to Borough Market
- 14.30 -15.30 Role of the nurse specialist
- 15.30-16.30 Difficult cases / Meeting about MEKi patients (once every 2 months)

- 9.00-9.30 Psychiatry meeting for NF1/NF2-related and other schwannomatosis
- 8.30 -13.00 On the second Wednesday of the month, the opportunity to attend an NF2 meeting with neuroradiology and discussion of cases with neurology. Skull base, neurosurgery, and genetics followed by the clinic.

Grant Amounts and Reimbursement

Once selected by the clinic and the program visit has been planned, the grantee will be contacted by CTF with a reimbursement procedure. CTF Europe will reimburse up to 500 Euro for travel in economy class, up to 150 Euros per night for lodging, and up to 50 Euros per day for food.
