Bullying

According to Box Elder School District's Board Policy 5270, bullying is defined as aggressive behavior that is:

- intended to cause distress and harm,
- exists in a relationship where there is an imbalance of power and strength,
- and is repeated over time.

At Sunrise High School, we encourage students to report all acts of bullying through the Anonymous Tip Line, or to a trusted adult, i.e., teacher, counselor, or administrator.

All reports of bullying are taken seriously and are investigated to the fullest extent.

Actions will be taken based on the specific needs and circumstances of each situation.

When bullying is identified, parents of both parties are made aware of the situation and the actions taken by administration to rectify the problem (as per district policy).
