



Proposal: Polkadot & Kusama Ecosystem events during Berlin Blockchain Week

Short description: This proposal aims to fund several activities organized by parachain teams during Berlin Blockchain week 9/12 - 9/18 2022

1. Context of the proposal:

This proposal aims to fund several activities organized by parachain teams during Berlin Blockchain week 9/12 - 9/18 2022. With this proposal we aim to receive a pre-payment to cover costs for the details stated in this proposal.

This proposal is a community led proposal, led by several parachains that have shown high interest in being part of the organizing team of this proposal. KILT Protocol, Phala Network, Subsquid, Crust Network, Bifrost, Basilisk and others came together to lay out a week full of Polkadot ecosystem events and educational content. However, every parachain is welcome to participate in the planning and organization of the events.

A public call has been made to initiate the organizing group for Berlin Blockchain Week. The parachain teams mentioned above have shown willingness to participate in the organization of the events,

During Berlin Blockchain Week there will also be EthBerlin 9/16- 9/18, which is a great opportunity for the Polkadot ecosystem to be present with several activities.

Instead of organizing a full one- or two-day conference as it has been done for example during EthCC in Paris, the organizer team decided to approach it in a different way and make use of the full seven days of Berlin Blockchain Week.

The goal is to organize every day a Polkadot specific event based on a different ecosystem topic (see layout below). Every event is organized in a different style (from boat party to panel discussion and NFT art gallery event) to show the diversity of our ecosystem and use every day of the blockchain week to promote the Polkadot brand.

As of now, the organizing team is not aware of any other Polkadot events during Berlin Blockchain Week. All funds of this proposal will go to the organization of the events. This proposal requests pre-funding for the planned events.



2. Problem statement:

During Berlin Blockchain Week there will also be EthBerlin 9/16- 9/18, the city will attract thousands of builders, developers, and blockchain enthusiasts. It will be the perfect opportunity for the Polkadot ecosystem to have a presence and grow our community and reach and educate audiences outside of our ecosystem.

3. Proposal Objective/solution/s to point 2:

3.1 The goal of the proposal

The goal of this proposal is to organize a Polkadot ecosystem event every other day during Berlin Blockchain Week 9/12 - 9/18 2022. Each event will be organized in different locations and organized by/with different parachain teams as well as speakers from in and outside the Polkadot ecosystem.

All educational events will be live streamed and the content will be published on Polkadot's official Crowdcast channel. All events live streams will be promoted as Polkadot Berlin Blockchain week events series.

3.2 How we will do this

- **Event communication process:**
 - It will be an RSVP style event: We will create an Meetup link for audience registration for free.

 - Audiences: Community, Web3 enthusiasts, crypto enthusiasts, Web3 developers, end-users. The total estimated audience number average 150 ppl per event, 600 in sum over all events

Evening event on UI/UX in DeFi

Hosted by: Composable Finance, Parallel Finance, organized by Polkadot Head Ambassador Zoé

Location: @FullNode Berlin (confirmed)

Estimate attendees: 90 people

An evening focusing on the current state and future of user-friendly UI/UX in crypto. Several parachain teams as well as outside ecosystem teams (e.g.Revolut, N26) will discuss UI/UX challenges, lessons learned and future improvements.

Speakers: Composable finance (confirmed), N26 (TBD), Revolut (TBD), Parallel Finance (confirmed), Parity (tbc)

Event 2: Tuesday 9/13, 6:30pm -10pm

Boat Drive with KILT Protocol and Authtrail

Hosted by: KILT Protocol & Authtrail

Location: Boat TBD, the offer will be provided

Estimate attendees: 100-130 people, snacks and drinks will be served

An evening boat drive from approx. 7pm - 10pm. This event will be led by KILT Protocol in cooperation with Authtrail. The event focuses on networking and getting to know other projects, alongside some short keynotes by KILT Protocol's Founder Ingo Rube and Authtrail's Matjaz Sobocan. The focus is beyond the Dotsama Ecosystem. The broader tech world and other blockchain ecosystems



will be invited to meet new people, projects, chains, ecosystems and to explore cross-chain / cross-ecosystem collaborations to get the Web3 movement going and discover new potential ideas.

Afternoon with Polkadot focusing on Cloud services in Web3

Hosted by: Polkadot, Crust Network and Phala Network

Location: FactoryBerlin

Estimate attendees: 150 people

Time: 4pm-8pm content, 8pm-10 pm social hour

This event will be a full afternoon of content with a following social hour at the very cool venue Factory Berlin (Görlitzer Park). The venue has a big blockchain community and will also host the official EthBerlin Hackathon on the following weekend.

During this event we want to focus on decentralized Cloud services and also provide a general update on the Polkadot ecosystem. Therefore, we will have speakers from parity and W3F joining to present and discuss current tech trends in Polkadot. Following we will be educating about available cloud services in the ecosystem and discuss decentralized cloud services overall. This event will be led by Phala Network in cooperation with Crust network. A panel discussion on cloud computation in web3 will be organized with speakers from Phala, Crust, Parity, Authtrail, IPFS and others following a social hour in the event location.

This event will be the closing event of the Polkadot ecosystem events series during Berlin Blockchain Week. The vision is to organize a half day event (5 hours) with content and following after party and a Berlin cool venue.

During this event, we are also planning to showcase several NFT art created by artists of the ecosystem. The organizing teams consult with all major L1s and NFT platforms in order to bring in a range of artists from across the ecosystem. Featured artists will be decided in discussion by NFT platform partners, including RMRK and Kodadot. The parachains from the organizing teams also have their own NFT collections which will be showcased at the NFT Gallery.

Especially in Berlin, one of the most creative cities in Europe, such an event will bring a lot of traction.

The time from 4:30pm to 7pm will be filled with several keynotes from parachains as well as parity including panel discussions.



The afterparty will be an official Polkadot ecosystem after party will live DJ, NFT art, food and drinks.

Since the funding of this proposal will support organizing Polkadot events during one of the most important weeks for the blockchain scene in Berlin, it will contribute to expanding the Polkadot brand and provide more awareness to our ecosystem.
