Hello from Sullivan Middle School! We are writing to share information about our upcoming school year! We are excited to welcome back our students, staff, parents, and community to a fantastic school year. As you know, Sullivan School District uses an online system called Lumen. Registration is all online, please check your email to make sure your child is registered online for the upcoming school year. Registration will open at the beginning of August, look for that in your email. This will not show your child’s teachers or schedules until registration is completed. Throughout the school year your child’s schedule, grades, attendance, and lunch balance for the 2026-2027 school year can be found by logging on to the parent portal in Lumen. We are very excited to see all our students and families at our registration and orientation days. Incoming 6th, 7th, and 8th grade students can come to our registration days to pick up their schedules on Wednesday, August 19 from 8:00 am-2:00 pm or Thursday, August 20 from 8:00 am-2:00 pm. Students will get their schedule for the 2026-2027 school year. They can find their lockers and put their items in their lockers to be ready for the first day of school. Incoming 6th grade students will have an WEB Retreat on August 13 from 8:00 am-12:00 pm at the Middle School. Students will be put in groups and meet their Web Leaders. There will be activities in the gym, students will go on a tour, find their locker, etc.

A few reminders:

The Sullivan School District Transportation Department policy states that each student will have a primary and secondary address for both their AM pick up and their PM drop off. These are the only addresses that the School District will pick up or drop off a student. Any changes must be made by the student’s parent or guardian 24 hours in advance with the office. Please review your family’s needs and ensure the bus/transportation information is updated.

The new school year starts Tuesday, August 25th. Students may arrive at 7:30 am., the first bell will ring at 7:55 am, the tardy bell will ring at 8:00 am.
