

## Student/Parent Application Guidelines

- I understand the college application process, am aware of college planning programs, and understand what classes or exams I need to graduate high school.
- I am aware that the Counseling Office requires **10 school days** to process a college application. I agree to fill out the college application form found on the school counseling webpage for every college to request that my college application be submitted with the materials that I need.
- I understand that I need to complete my resume and the student perspective sheet to have a recommendation written for me.
- I am aware that I need to send my ACT/SAT scores myself through the testing websites to the colleges that require them.
- In order to have a faculty member (other than counselor) write a recommendation letter for me, I need to ask them at least **10 school days** prior to my deadline to complete the task. I also understand I need to provide them with my resume/ student perspective sheet if requested.
- I understand that the College & Career Center requires **5 school days** to process a scholarship application. If I need a recommendation letter, application to be filled out or transcript, etc. I will notify and provide the needed materials to the Counseling Office within the requested time frame. Please pay attention to due dates written on applications, not the dates that the scholarship has provided to ensure that they arrive at their location on time.
