## Lesson 6: Vowel Sounds

The Arabic language has two kinds of sounds: letters and vowel sounds. In this book, we will explore the vowels first.

There are three حَرَكَات (ha-ra-kaat), or vowel sounds in Arabic. The chart below shows how the vowels are drawn, their names in Arabic, and how they are shaped using your mouth.

Vowel	Name in Arabic	Sound	Length	Mouth Shape
سَ	فَتْحَة (fatHa)	a	1 count	Open mouth
سُ	ضَمَّة (dhamma)	u	1 count	Circle lips
سِ	كَسْرَة (kasra)	e	1 count	Lower jaw

**It is important before we continue that you master these sounds cleanly.** Unlike English, vowel sounds in Arabic carry their own meaning. If you were to pronounce one vowel sound like another, or forget a vowel sound, it can change the meaning. Here is an example:
