The full-season RFC Apprenticeship fee is \$700 for Apprentices in the Portland, Rogue Valley, and Willamette Valley chapters. The full-season fee is \$485 for Distanced Apprentices outside of those regions. Short-season and distanced Apprentices pay a reduced fee based on the number of events they will attend. It is highly recommended to participate in the full series. Payment plans are available to pay over the course of the season. Scholarships are available to applicants who identify as Black, Indigenous, Latine or other Person of Color, LGBTQIA2s+, veteran, previously incarcerated, living with a disability, and/or low-income.
