## **Projects**

**Capstone Project- *Shadowing a Neurologist***

Eglin Air Force Base Hospital

August 2022-March 2023

During my 15-hour shadowing experience, I observed and gained firsthand insight into the neurological and psychological impacts of the military. I witnessed patient evaluations, learned about diagnostic methods such as neuroimaging, and discussed the role of social connectivity in brain health. Through this experience and my research project, I deepened my understanding of the relationship between social isolation and conditions such as anxiety, depression, and cognitive decline, enhancing my knowledge of how environmental factors can influence neurological function and overall well-being.
