

Social Media Tips and Tricks





Consider:

- Leverage the power of reposting other people's content use the hashtags to find other folks/coops sharing this content, engage with it by liking, commenting and sharing
- Take note of when you're posting (when is your target audience online?)
- Consider who you're tagging (tag your fellow COWOPers!)
- Ensure your call to action is clear
 - Push people to send letters to their reps via <u>bit.ly/COWOPaction</u>
 - Make sure the link works!
 - For Instagram put the link in your bio or use the link feature in stories
- Organizing in the comments
 - Respond to comments!
 - Tag people in the comments
 - Use <u>COWOP talking points</u>
- Frequency of content how often are you posting?
 - Request to post about this campaign 1x per week
- Don't forget to tell them when we've WON!
