## **Tools for synchronous learning:**

(check with your district on which options you have available)

- Google Meet
  - o Record using the present feature, it will save to google drive to be shared later
  - o Helpful Extensions: Google Meets Attendance
- Zoom
  - o use the annotate tool to interact on a whiteboard or other screen
  - Change the virtual background

## **Recording lesson videos:**

- <u>Screencastify</u> (extension)- free version is limited to five minutes a video
  - Pro version is currently free during the shutdown
    To activate Screencastify Unlimited access, follow these instructions:
    - Visit this page and click "Redeem coupon" (under the Next Billing Date)
    - Enter code CAST\_COVID
    - Click "Activate License" (no credit card required). Ignore the Next Billing Date that will be incorrect

- Educreations (app for iPad and chromebook)
  - Use the link to set up the free pro version currently available
- Explain Everything (app and on chromebook)
  - Record lesson, live interactive (whiteboard option for using with google meet)
- Notability (iPad app or Mac app)
- Loom just like screencastify but free for education right now with unlimited time

## **Recording Audio:**

 Online Voice Recorder - saves as MP3, add to your google drive to add to assignments and google slides

## Best Practices:

Keep videos short and simple! Students lose interest after 3 - 5 minutes.

Tools to Use with Google Classroom/Canvas/Seesaw

- <u>Jamboard</u> online whiteboard with sticky note option to be used within google apps.
  Can be shared out as an assignment or as a collaborative whiteboard.
- <u>Padlet</u> digital bulletin board, students can post with audio, video, written, pictures, files, etc...
- Flipgrid Students post a video response to your prompt, you give feedback, integrated whiteboard, and other tools make this interactive for students and teachers
  - How to get started with Flipgrid
  - New Feature! Use Flipgrid to do a screen record!
- <u>Classkick</u> Upload questions, pictures, pdfs allows students to type, draw, etc. over assignments on one screen for easy monitoring and grading by teachers
  - o Similar: GoFormative
- Edcite or Edulastic
  - Create online assignments that grade and collect answers for you lots of precreated lessons in the libraries. Connects to GClassroom
  - o Edcite Oregon Specific Page
  - Edulastic has added kiosk mode (locks students into assessments)
- Doc Hub (extension) to annotate and write on PDFs
  - Kami (extension as well)
- Read Receipts how to know if students are seeing your emails or Google Classroom Assignments
  - How to Video
  - Blog post explaining the setting
